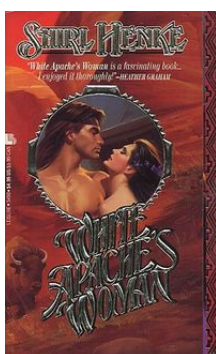


# WHITE APACHE'S WOMAN
