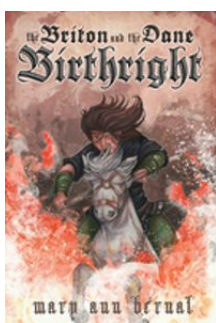


THE BRITON AND THE DANE: BIRTHRIGHT
