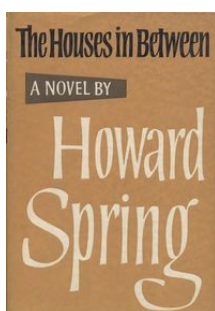


THE HOUSES IN BETWEEN
