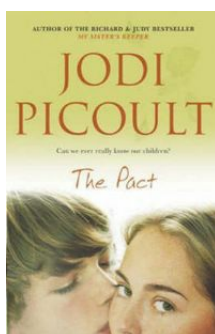


# THE PACT
